Dual Enrollment Courses Available @ NSTM!

High School Juniors & Seniors are invited to take courses at the *Northeast School of Theology and Ministry!* Here are the details:



- What is *Dual Enrollment?* Dual enrollment is taking college level courses
 that can be approved as credit toward your high school diploma, PLUS
 count at college level credit at NSTM or possible transfer credit to other
 colleges of your choice. For more info go to: www.NortheastSTM.org
- . Where & when are these courses offered? NSTM has 3 campuses in Big Flats (Horseheads area), Attica (Rochester area), and Preble (Cortland-Syracuse area). Our courses are usually offered 1 weekend per month from September-June, on a Friday evening & all-day Saturday.
- What type of courses are offered at NSTM? We offer courses in Biblical Studies (Old & New Testament), Doctrinal Studies (Theology), & Practical Ministry courses. Many of these courses may qualify as a required or elective high school Bible course at most Christian high schools. All of our courses are either 1 credit (1 weekend in a month) or 2 credits (2 weekends in consecutive months).
- What is the cost of courses at NSTM? We do our best to offer affordable, reasonable cost courses. Each course is only \$100 per credit (compared to the normal rate of \$350+ per credit at most Christian colleges).
- What do I need to do to sign up for classes?
 - o Look at the list of courses on the back of this flyer.
 - Choose the course(s) that interest you, then check with your high school guidance counselor to see if they will accept these course credits toward your high school diploma. If they have questions about the courses, they may contact Dr. Lee Kliewer, NSTM Dean, at Ikliewer1956@gmail.com
 - Complete the form on the back, and mail it along with your tuition payment to the NSTM office address.
 - Once we receive your course registration, we will contact you about course information and send a course syllabus to you.
 - o A final course grade will be sent to your school upon completion.
